## **R-Squared Productions Plans Historic Event**

MONROE, LA, February 3, 2012—The time has finally come. R-Squared Productions' latest, and much-anticipated, feature-length film, *New Hope* will premiere at First West in West Monroe on Friday, February 10. The film, which boldly tackles common teenage issues, features Ben Davies (Courageous), Perry Frost, and Samuel Davis (Abel's Field), as well as hundreds of local extras, basketball players, and cheerleaders. In addition, *New Hope* features multiple songs written and performed by local artists. The film's stars are expected to be in attendance for the black-tie, red-carpet affair that will begin at 7:00 pm this Friday. That's only the beginning of the festivities that will make *New Hope* historic. Movie showings will continue nightly through February 19. Almost every day of showings will have a theme. For example, Saturday, February 11, will mark "Wristband Day". On that day only, those extras and volunteers who helped on-set during the filming of *New Hope* and received a special wristband will get in to any showing free, simply be showing their wristband. Other special promotions include:
